## 5. **Executive Director Update**

SM informed the board of the current figures, regarding cruise and land-based visitors. Numbers are now close to reaching those achieved previously in the 2019/20 season pre-covid.

SM noted the increase in cruise passenger spend which was encouraging. It was noted that the satellite account would be updated once the National Accounts for 2020 were complete; this helps determine tourism contribution to GDP.

SM also bought up the topic of the License to Operate system and the changes that will be implemented for the upcoming season; full details will be announced at the Wash Up meeting at the beginning of April. SM also highlighted the increased sales of goods from local suppliers which has increased significantly since the 2021/2022 season.

SM moved on to discussing Avian Influenza and its impact on the current season. SM also noted that she wanted to give a special mention to Sea Lion Island regarding the difficulties they have faced this season not only with Avian flu and the unexpected closure of the lodge, but also with the recent wildfire. The FITB board wished them well in a speedy recovery.

SM updated the Board on the pontoons, saying work is due to commence as soon as the season is over.
